

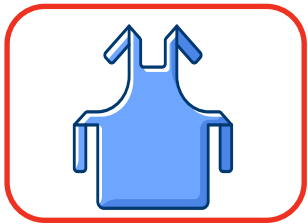
Red Room - Instructions for all Staff

****THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE NOT FOR AREAS WHERE AGP's ARE BEING UNDERTAKEN**
Essential visiting only permitted. Visitors should wear surgical mask/ eye protection and apron.

PPE Requirements in order of donning



Type 2R Surgical mask (FRSM)
Worn at all times



Aprons
Worn at all times within 2M of patient. (Gown if extensive splashing anticipated)



Eye Protection
Worn at all times within 2M of patient



Gloves
Worn at all times for direct patient care

Cleaning Requirements

Environment Cleaning
(Frequency - Twice a day)

Chlorine based detergent ONLY (1000ppm)
(Actichlor Plus / Prosan Plus)

Equipment Cleaning
(Frequency - after use / between patients)

- **Chlorine based Detergent** (Actichlor Plus / Prosan Plus)
- OR
- **Yellow Detergent wipes followed by Alcohol wipe**
- OR
- **A Green Universal Wipe**

Blood & Body Fluid Contamination

Should be cleaned with Chlorine based detergent using appropriate concentrations
