

AGE DIVERSITY – YOUTH FOCUSED

OVERVIEW

This workshop will provide an overview of age diversity and will have a specific youth focus. Young people when approaching and attending their GP Practice can often feel excluded, intimidated, unsure and unaware of the support available to them. It is therefore essential that staff have the necessary skills to deal with young people and understand young people's perceptions and culture.

This session will highlight young person's perceptions of the NHS and will also concentrate on attitudes to age and confidentiality. Staff will gain the necessary skills to adapt their approach in dealing, supporting and engaging with young people effectively.
