

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This plan sets the strategic direction for Renfrewshire CHP for the three years from April 2010. It is underpinned by NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde's Corporate Planning and Policy Frameworks, and builds on our joint work with Renfrewshire Council and other partners through our Community Plan 2008-2017 and the Single Outcome Agreement (SOA). The purpose of the plan is to provide a clear focus to how we deliver effective and high quality health services, to improve the health and wellbeing of the population of Renfrewshire and to do all we can to address the wider social determinants of health which cause health inequalities.
- 1.2 The plan focuses on the outcomes we aim to achieve in the three year period, describing the changes and activities which are required to deliver them. It is not a description of the CHP and the services we deliver as our routine business. This outcomes focus on planning is mirrored in Renfrewshire's Community Plan and SOA.
- 1.3 The Planning and Policy Frameworks allow us to be explicit about our role in delivering the NHS system-wide outcomes, ensuring consistency across all the areas of NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde. The frameworks are as follows:
