What is the Public Partnership Forum (PPF)?


The Public Partnership Forum (PPF) is the 'public voice' on West Glasgow Community Health and Care Partnership (CHCP). It enables the public, service users and carers to be involved in decisions about local health and social care services. The PPF is made up of representatives of local groups and individuals living in West Glasgow who use or are interested in health and social care services.

The PPF has an Executive Committee with 26 members elected annually from local community groups, voluntary organisations and local residents. The Executive Committee meets at least six times a year and organises at least two public events each year.

What does the Public Partnership Forum (PPF) do?

The PPF supports West Glasgow Community Health and Care Partnership (CHCP) by

- Providing opportunities for local residents to express their views about services and what the priorities should be
- Informing local people about health and social care services and proposals to change them
- Consulting with the community about how to improve local health and social care services and making suggestions to the CHCP
- Being involved in various service planning and decision-making processes.

What is West Glasgow Community Health and Care Partnership?

West Glasgow CHCP provides local primary care, community health and social work services in a joined-up way with the aim of improving health and wellbeing of the local population and tackling inequalities.

The CHCP area covers a variety of communities from Drumchapel in the West to High Street in the East.
